

TKA Homeschool (Independent Study Program) Diploma Requirements

A TKA Independent Study Program Diploma will be awarded upon satisfactory completion of:

- 24 Credits of study
 - .5 credit = 67 hours of instruction
 - 1 credit= 132 hours of instruction
- A score of 18 on the ACT or a score of 900 SAT (CR/V + math) by fall of senior year. A copy of the official score report can be submitted or when signing up for the ACT or SAT put TKA’s school code- 432015- and a copy of testing is automatically sent to TKA.

A student may only earn a maximum of 8 credits in one year. Any student who plans to complete all graduation requirements in less than 4 years must give written notification and submit an approved plan by the beginning of the sophomore year.

Testing (required) given at TKA

- 9th grade: pre-ACT, PSAT
- 10th grade: pre-ACT, PSAT
- 11th grade: PSAT, ACT or SAT
- 12TH grade: ACT or SAT

Students can participate in our graduation ceremony in May, but this is not required to earn the diploma.
